### A Revelation & A Rescue

### Questions for Reflection/Discussion:

If you believe Jesus is God, how did you come to that realization? If you aren't there yet, what prevents you from believing it?

How does Jesus being God change the way we follow him?

What gives you confidence that God is with you as you go throughout your life?

How would you explain courage? How can Jesus increase its presence in our lives?

What was your biggest take away from this passage?
